Chief Jennings answered questions regarding the documents. Following the discussion, Acting Chairman Walker asked for a vote to approve and sign the temporary permit license. Clerk McNulty made a motion to accept, OFDBM Arias seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion passed. Again, Acting Chairman Walker asked for a motion to accept and sign the lease agreements. Clerk McNulty made the

motion, OFDBM Arias seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion passed. After a brief clarification, Acting Chairman Walker asked for a motion to amend the previous vote to allow Chief Jennings to sign the sublease agreement with PHI Health, LLC, instead of the Board. Clerk McNulty made a motion and OFDBM Arias seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion passed.
